Certificates can be earned each week.

There is a parent area on the website, which includes access to a guide explaining how you can get more out of Mathletics, perhaps by opting to receive weekly email progress reports.

User names and passwords remain unchanged. If pupils have forgotten theirs, everyone will receive a passcard from their mathematics teacher which will be stuck into the Learning Link.
