## Curriculum Information

### Ash Class, Summer Term 2021- Wild Side



#### **Communication, Language and Literacy/ English**

This term we will focus on the text 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jefferies. The children will retell the story both verbally and through their writing and then write their own versions. We will also study the characters in the book. We will write information texts about animals. We will also create our own animal poems, thinking about descriptive language and rhyme. In addition to this, we will continue to have daily phonics, handwriting and reading sessions.

#### **Understanding the world/Science**

In Science this term we will look at Plants and Mini-beasts.

We will be learning the different parts of plants and trees and how to grow plants. We will also look at the best conditions for plants to grow in. We will be growing our own seeds to test out different growing conditions.

We will look at a range of mini-beasts and their body parts. We will investigate where they live and make our own mini-beast habitats.

#### **Mathematics**

**FS-** We will be counting and recognising numbers to 20 and beyond, adding and subtracting, solving problems using doubling, halving and sharing. Creating own repeating patterns. Telling the time to o'clock and naming the days of the week in order.

**Yr1-** Pupils will be multiplying and dividing using knowledge of 2s, 5s and 10s. Fractions, position and direction. Place value, money and time. Telling the time to o'clock and half past and knowing the days of the week and months of the year.

#### **RE**

This term we will explore the big question; What is happening in the natural world this term?

We will learn about the Christian Creation story, explore and observe the natural world and seasonal changes around us on the school grounds and use talk, drawing and writing to develop our ideas about Creation and the natural world.



#### **Understanding the World/Geography-**

We will identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles. We will use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, as well as the countries, continents and oceans. We will look at how areas of the world are different from each other with regard to weather, landscapes, habitats etc...

**Art & DT:** Landscapes and Habitat dioramas.

**Music:** We will be exploring pitch and rhythm using instruments and movement; learning and performing nursery rhymes and songs related to animals, mini-beasts and the world around us.

**PE:** Games and Gymnastics, PE will be on a Monday and Wednesday.

**PSHE:** The children will explore leading a healthy lifestyle by looking at how amazing our bodies are. We will be looking at how we have changed since we were babies and the amazing things we can do now.

**Computing:** Children will become confident using computer skills including logging on and off the computers, using a range of ICT, choosing and completing a simple program and learning how we can use the internet to find out information.
