

Daily Tasks- Ash- EYFS

With so many resources out there, we wanted to provide you with a simple, suggested list of 'learning tasks' that you should try and complete each day with your child/ children to ensure they continue to learn and build on the skills they have recently gained. These should fit in with our suggested timetable.

Please do also spend some time looking through the resources we have uploaded to our class web pages, to familiarise yourself with what is available to you and how you could use them.

Each day aim to spend time on:

Subject:	Suggestions:
Reading	Phonic based reading book, Oxford Owls online, share a story, read a comic, spot the words you know in any text.
Phonics	Play phonics play, practice phonemes (see downloadable phonics mats), practise phase 2 and 3 tricky words. Read and write words containing known phonemes, include a mix of real and alien words. Children should practice all phase 2 phonemes and then move through phase 3 as ready.
Handwriting	Work on formation of one letter a day. See letter families download on class webpage for the suggested order to practice.
Writing	Twinkl home learning pack, keep a diary, write cvc words/ sentences to practice phonic skills. Retell a favourite story. Talk about capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
Maths	Mathletics, Twinkl home learning pack activities. Each week you could have a different focus for Maths- 1) Practise counting, ordering, recognizing and writing numbers 1-20. 2) Recognise and talk about simple 2D and 3D shapes e.g. shape of faces, does it roll? Make shape models. 3) Make repeating patterns using colour and shape. 4) Practise adding and subtracting numbers using numbers to 10. Extend when able. Solve practically and move to recording when ready. 5) Count in 2s, 5s and 10s 6) Find double and halves to 10.

You should also make time for the other areas of the curriculum as suggested in the 'timetable'.
