Find a story with repeated language and bring it in to share with the class.

Write some labels to accompany the picture/photo of your house.

Practise writing your name with correct formation. Can you write it using large letters for display?

### Science

Can you look for different habitats near your house? Who lives there? What makes it a good habitat? Can you build a bug hotel in your garden using natural materials? Bring in some photos to show what you have made.

### RE

Can you create a special place at home? Can you build a den or create a cosy corner? Take a photo of you in your special place to share.

Can you think of a special person in your life? It could be a friend or someone in your family. Draw your special person and label with their name.

### History & Geography

Have you visited a city before? Can you bring in any photos/ pictures or maps to show? Can you talk about where you visited?

Find out about a famous Britain from the past or present. Can you share a fact you have found out with the class?

Can you bring in a photo or draw a picture of your house that we can use on our map of the local area?

### Mathematics

Can you do some cooking at home? Bring in some photos of the things you have made. Can you help to weigh the ingredients?

Do some measuring home. What can you find that is taller than you and shorter than you?

Can you find items that are heavier/ lighter than you? Take some photos and bring them in to share.
