English

Find a story with repeated language and bring it in to share with the class.

Write some labels to accompany the picture/photo of your house.

Can you write a poem about a city in the UK?

Visit www.phonicsplay.co.uk and play as many games as possible (FS -Phase 1 and 2 and Year 1s Phase 3-5).

Science

What is a scientist? Can you find this out? Do you know the names of any famous scientists? Can you tell the class why they are famous? Create a poster or leaflet to show the information you have found.

RE

How are different events/ times of the year celebrated in your house? Can you bring in a photo of a special celebration who have been part of? E.g. a wedding, christening, Easter. Can you talk to the class about the celebration?

History & Geography

Have you visited a city before? Can you bring in any photos/ pictures or maps to show? Can you talk about where you visited?

Find out about your family, present or past. Can you share a fact you have found out with the class? Can you make a family tree?

Can you bring in a photo or draw a picture of your house that we can use on our map of the local area?

Mathematics

Can you do some cooking at home? Bring in some photos of the things you have made. Can you help to weigh the ingredients?

Do some measuring home. What can you find that is taller than you and shorter than you?

Can you find items that are heavier/ lighter than you? Take some photos and bring them in to share.
