Science

Go on a mini-beast/wildlife hunt around your garden/local area. Which insects/bugs/animals can you find? Where do they like to live? Do they like the dark? Do they live underground? Can you find a nest? Can you take a photo of the different habitats you find?

Can you research a Christian bible story and re write it in your own words?

Can you find similarities and differences between Christians and Sihks? Can you record this in an interesting way?

History & Geography

Can you research where your favourite animal lives? Can you write some facts about your favourite animal?

Which countries have you visited? Bring in some photos to show where you have been. Can you tell the class something interesting about the country?

Can you use the internet or a book to find out about countries with a hot/ cold climate?

Mathematics

Learn the days of the week/ months of the year off by heart. Can you recite them to the class in a loud, clear voice?

Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Can you create a poster explaining the easiest way to divide/multiply numbers?
