Teaching and Learning

- Whole class and small group sessions for Maths and English to meet the needs of the individual children.
- Teacher, TA, and sometimes other support in class e.g. MFL/PE.
- Assessment – ongoing assessment in class to adapt learning for the next day and commencing weeks. Children are also assessed at the beginning and end of topics to show progress and to inform the next stages of teaching.
- Marking and feedback is a dialogue between pupils and teacher to further learning, tickled pick and green for growth. The children also respond to comments during the lesson in purple pen to address misconceptions continually.

Last week in Pine class

Last week in Pine Class, we enjoyed finding out about sound in science. We learned that sound is created by vibrations. In geography, we were learning about the countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom. In art, we were looking at different sculptures and we looked at a famous one called The Angel of the North. In computing, we were talking about how to keep safe online and that if you open a link or pop-up it could contain a virus which could damage your computer. In English, we worked hard to write a detailed set of instructions for how to catch an alien spaceship. In maths, we have been using resources to help us solve problems about place value. Using Base10 and place value grids really helped us to understand.

As part of our geography topic, we will be using a map to identify and name some of the main rivers in the UK. On Thursday and Friday we are very excited to be taking part in two virtual workshops as part of a creative writing project we are part of. In maths, we will be solving problems linked to our understanding of place value. In science, we will be investigating how sounds are made. As part of our E-Safety learning, we will be thinking about how to keep our personal information safe and how to create a strong password. In RE, we will be focusing on the story of 'The Lost Son' and we will be asking questions to improve our understanding of what Christians learnt from the story. In PSHE, we will be looking at strategies for building collaborative relationships within the class and the school.
