Curriculum Information - **Topic: This is Me!**

Ash Class, Autumn Term 2022



## English

This term we will be reading stories with predictable phrasing. Children will be learning to write sentences and short stories with patterned language and familiar words and phrases.

We will learn how to write texts with the purpose to inform. We will also be reading and writing poetry linked to our topic: This is me!

This year, children will have daily phonics, handwriting, and spelling or grammar sessions. They will also have guided reading sessions that allow them to explore contexts of stories.

## Science

Our Science topic for this term is Seasonal Changes. Children will investigate and learn about the four seasons, name different types of weather and make observations. They will also be able to describe the weather associated with each season and collect and record simple data.

## Mathematics

**EYFS** - This term we will introduce and build on basic number concepts. We will learn number rhymes and play number games. Children will count sets of objects, recognise and order numbers.

**Yr1**- The children are going to be learning about place value with numbers up to 20. The children will be learning addition and subtraction up to 50. The children will also be learning about geometry and the property of shapes.

## RE – Creation

In RE, EYFS will be exploring Christianity and Islam. They will understand why the word 'God' is so important to Christians and how this is similar/different to Islam.

**Yr1** - Christianity – Why was Jesus given the name Saviour?

Judaism – Why do Jewish families talk about repentance at New Year?



## History and Geography

In Geography, we will be exploring where we live and our local area using basic geographical language to refer to key physical and human features. We will devise simple maps and use symbols in a key. We will compare our locality to some other places in the world.

In History, we will be thinking about our lives so far, creating simple family trees and comparing the childhood of our parents and grandparents to our own.

## Other subjects

**Art & DT:** In Art we will be learning about self-portraits in the past and present and learning to create our own self-portraits using a variety of media. In DT we will take inspiration from puppets around the world and look at how they are made. We will design and make a puppet.

**Music:** Working World from Music Express

**PE:** Fundamentals and Trails, trust and team work.

**PSHE:** Myself and My Relationships – me and my emotions.

**Computing:** Children will be learning how to stay safe online and developing their digital literacy skills.
