Curriculum Information

Elm Class, Summer Term 2021- Wild Side



Communication, Language and Literacy/ English

This term we will be looking at traditional tales. We will be looking at traditional stories we are all familiar with before writing our own.

We will write information texts about animals. We will also create our own animal poems, thinking about descriptive language and rhyme. We will also be revisiting diary entries and focusing on our sentence structures throughout.

In addition to this, we will continue to have daily phonics, handwriting and reading sessions.

Understanding the world/Science

In Science this term we will look at Plants and Minibeasts.

We will be learning the different parts of plants and trees and what is their purpose. We will be learning about wild plants and how to grow plants. The best conditions for plants to grow in and why.

We will be growing our own sunflowers and cress to test out different growing conditions and the impact this has on growth.

Mathematics

Year 1- Pupils will be learning about fractions. Looking at halves and quarters of objects and amounts. Revisiting addition and subtraction within 50. Pupils will be multiplying and dividing using knowledge of 2s, 5s and 10s. Pupils will be learning about money in pence and pounds.

Year 2- Pupils will be learning about fractions. Looking at halves and quarters of objects and amounts, finding and recognising thirds, unit and non-unit fractions. We will be revisiting addition and subtraction to 100. Pupils will be multiplying and dividing building on previous learning and knowledge. We will also be learning about money, counting the correct amount and giving change.

RE

In RE we will be learning about Christianity through books and stories. We will explore the meanings behind the stories.

We will also be learning about Sikhism. The children will be looking at stories from the guru's and the different concepts of Seva.



Understanding the World/Geography-

We will identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles. We will use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, as well as the countries, continents and oceans. We will look at how areas of the world are different from each other such as Kenya with regard to weather, landscapes, habitats etc...

Art & DT: Landscapes and Habitat dioramas.

Music: Our World – we will be exploring pitch, rhythm and instruments; learning and performing nursery rhymes and songs related to animals, minibeasts and the world around us.

PE: Games and Gymnastics, PE will be on a Tuesday and Thursday

PSHE: The children will explore leading a healthy lifestyle by looking at how amazing our bodies are, some of the things our bodies can do and how to look after our bodies by following basic hygiene procedures.

Computing: Children will become confident using computer skills including logging on and off the computers, using a range of ICT, choosing and completing a simple program and learning how we can use the internet to find out information.
